Our members can be seen on the road, in the hills, on tandems, on recumbents and often pulling kids in trailers,” says incoming president Chris Lougee. “We also offer volunteer opportunities to get involved and help the community by promoting safe bicycle riding, supporting other organizations and sponsoring community cycling events.”

Secretary Richard Pastcan explains “The Tour of Napa Valley is our main fund raiser. All proceeds beyond those necessary to put on the tour and run the Eagle Cycling Club are donated to local non-profits and youth cycling organizations. These have included all ten local volunteer fire departments, Napa County Safe Routes to School, The Skyline Park Association, The Napa Bicycle Coalition, the Redwood Empire Mountain Bike Association (REMBA), the Napa High School Bicycle Club, and the St. Helena Thunderbirds Youth Mountain Bike Club, among others. The total donations over the years go well into six figures.”

“Our weekly rides are open to everyone, not just members,” says Ride Director, Doug Pettie.
