### Registration

Online pre-registration only on <https://www.bikereg.com/cherry-pie> for a small surcharge. We will have a release form generated for you to sign on race day. (Under 18 needs parent or guardian signature). **Add \$5 to registration fee after Sunday, February 3, 2019 or pay an additional \$15 for first entry on same day registration.** Registration opens at 7:00 a.m., closes 20 minutes before start of each event. Entry fee includes NCNCA surcharge and USAC Insurance.

**2019 USAC license required:** USA Cycling racing license required to race. One day licenses available for CAT 5 Men & Women. All other CATs must hold a current annual license (available at race registration or on-line at [usacycling.org](http://usacycling.org)). Additional races qualify for a discounted registration fee of \$25.

### Course

This course is on the grounds of Napa Valley College. The new (same or similar to prior years) technical 1.1 mile course features right hand turns and left hand turns, a chicane, a wide roundabout, and a moderate rise in the finish stretch. Directions will be Clockwise. Free lap rule will be applied per the USA Cycling rules.

### Location & Directions

**From SF:** Take 101 north, 37 exit (Napa) make a left turn at light (Napa), follow directions to Napa, at "T" take right (Hwy 29 south), go over river on bridges, make left at light (Hwy 221), the left at light at Streblow Dr. Follow signs to parking.

**From Sacramento:** Right on Hwy 29 North and exit right onto Hwy 221, make a left at Streblow Dr. Follow signs to parking.

From East Bay: Right onto Hwy 221, Left onto Streblov Dr. Follow signs to parking

Note: Streblov Dr. remains open. Please do your best to carpool.
